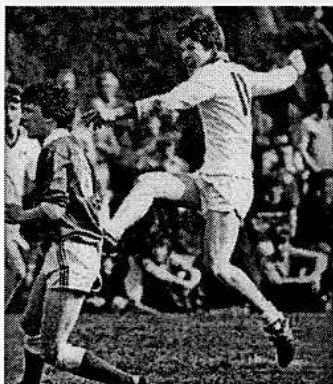


Micháel Molloy Trust Fund



Hi,

We would like to thank you for expressing an interest in taking part in the "Hike for Mike" event on May Bank Holiday weekend 2007. As you are aware, the primary objective for each "Hiker" is to lead a team that will raise €2,500 for the Micháel Molloy Trust Fund. In order to ensure that Hiker teams meet their Fundraising target, we have structured the event in the following manner.

- An individual expresses an interest in being a Hiker on the "Hike for Mike" event to one of the Trustees and is supplied with an information pack explaining the format and Fundraising targets for the Challenge
- Individual completes & returns registration slip below committing themselves to raise €500 sponsorship
- On return of the Registration slip to the event organising committee, the "Hiker" is officially registered
- The "Hiker" then recruits a minimum of 4 Fundraisers to assist in raising a further €2,000 for his/her team
- Each "Fundraiser" will get 2 sponsored cards to raise money for their Hiker Team
- The "Hiker" team reach their overall target of €2,500 and the entire team take part in the "Hike for Mike" Mountain Challenge in May 2007, details on Mountain Challenge format overleaf

We are confident that this is going to be a unique event and should prove very enjoyable for all involved. If, having read this briefing pack, you feel more comfortable taking part in the event as a "Fundraiser", please indicate on the slip attached. The role of the "Fundraiser" in assisting Hikers in raising the overall fundraising target will be crucial to the success of this event. All "Fundraisers" can join their "Hiker" on the Hike from Tourmakeady or join their Hiker for the climb of Crough Patrick. This will ensure that all the people involved in the event will get the opportunity to Climb the Holy Mountain of Croagh Patrick and be part of the overall challenge.

"Hike for Mike"

30 mile Mountain challenge

The Challenge:

Starting at Molloy's House in Tourmakeady, the Hiker teams will begin their Hike and cross the mountains up from Derryveeny. The Mountain Hikers will walk an age-old pilgrimage trail from Tourmakeady to Croagh Patrick on the Drummin side (30 miles round trip). Hikers can also walk an alternative route via the mountain road through Glenmask connecting to the Westport/Leenaun road .

Once the Hikers reach the foot of Croagh Patrick on the Drummin side, they will take a rest and freshen up before beginning the climb. All Fundraisers can join their "Hiker" on the Hike from Tourmakeady or join their Hiker for the climb of Crough Patrick. This will ensure that all the people involved in the event will get the opportunity to Climb the Holy Mountain of Croagh Patrick and be part of the overall challenge.

After climbing Croagh Patrick, the Hiker teams will descend to bottom of Croagh Patrick on the Clew Bay side and walk to Pat Gibbons Holiday House in Murrisk. Pat is a friend of the Molloy's in Chicago and has very kindly offered to provide washing & sleeping facilities, food, refreshments & entertainment on site for all involved. The next morning, all Hiker teams will be transported by Bus to the Drummin side of Croagh Patrick for the return hike to Tourmakeady.

Timetable for the Challenge & Social events

- All involved will meet at Molloy's House in Tourmakeady at 9am on Saturday 5th May
- Hiker teams set out on the Hike and should reach Croagh Patrick around 5pm
- Fundraisers can join their Hiker team on Saturday evening to climb Croagh Patrick
- Hiker Teams descend on the Clew Bay side of mountain and walk to Gibbons House
- All involved freshen up and avail of food, refreshments & entertainment on site
- Hikers can then bed down for a good nights sleep on Saturday night
- Next morning Sunday 6th May at 9am, Hiker teams are transported by Bus to Drummin
- Return Hike back begins, Hikers should reach Tourmakeady by Sunday mid-afternoon
- On completion of the challenge, Hiker teams freshen up, eat meal and rest a few hours
- Reception for all people involved in event at Paddy's Bar Sunday evening (starting 8pm)

The Fundraising Structure:

There will be both "Hikers" and "Fundraisers" taking part in the "Hike for Mike" Mountain challenge to raise funds for the Michael Molloy Trust Fund. Each Hiker will be expected to commit themselves to raising €500 for the Trust Fund to be officially registered as a Hiker for the event. Each "Hiker" will then recruit a minimum of 4 "Fundraisers" to their team to raise target of €2,500. The "Fundraisers" will be given 2 sponsorship cards with 50 sponsored lines on each card to fill. An example of fundraising structure is:

1 "Hiker" commits to raising €500 for Trust Fund and is officially registered

1 "Hiker" recruits minimum 4 "Fundraisers" to their team, all get 2 cards each = 10 cards

1 Hiker team (1 Hiker + 4 Fundraisers) with 10 cards filled @ average € 250 per card = € 2,500

40 Hiker teams x € 2,500 per team = € 100,000 raised for Trust Fund
